DATA PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

This policy complies with the Personal Data Protection Act 2010 (“the Act”) and applies to Choo Bee Metal Industries Berhad (“Company”) and its subsidiaries (“the Group”). This policy also explains how we go about using and safeguarding personal information collected from you, or that you provide to the Group, while ensuring your personal data is protected.

2. The Application of This Policy

This Policy applies to all personal data and information with whom we conduct business with and to the management of such data and information in any form, whether in electronic or written form.

3. Our Collection of Personal Information

The term "personal data" in this Policy refers to personal information which is capable of identifying you as an individual. We will request you to voluntarily supply us with the specific data required to enter into commercial transactions with you or to deliver the necessary notices and products in connection with our business.

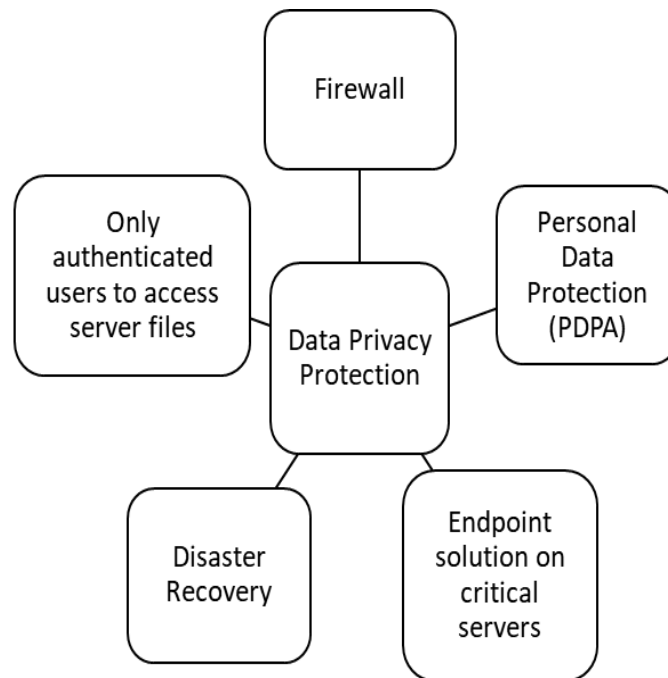
4. Responsibility for Data Security

- i. To prevent the misuse of your personal data as well as your data from being breached by people who do not have access permission, we have implemented appropriate physical, electronic and managerial measures to protect and secure the personal data that we collect.

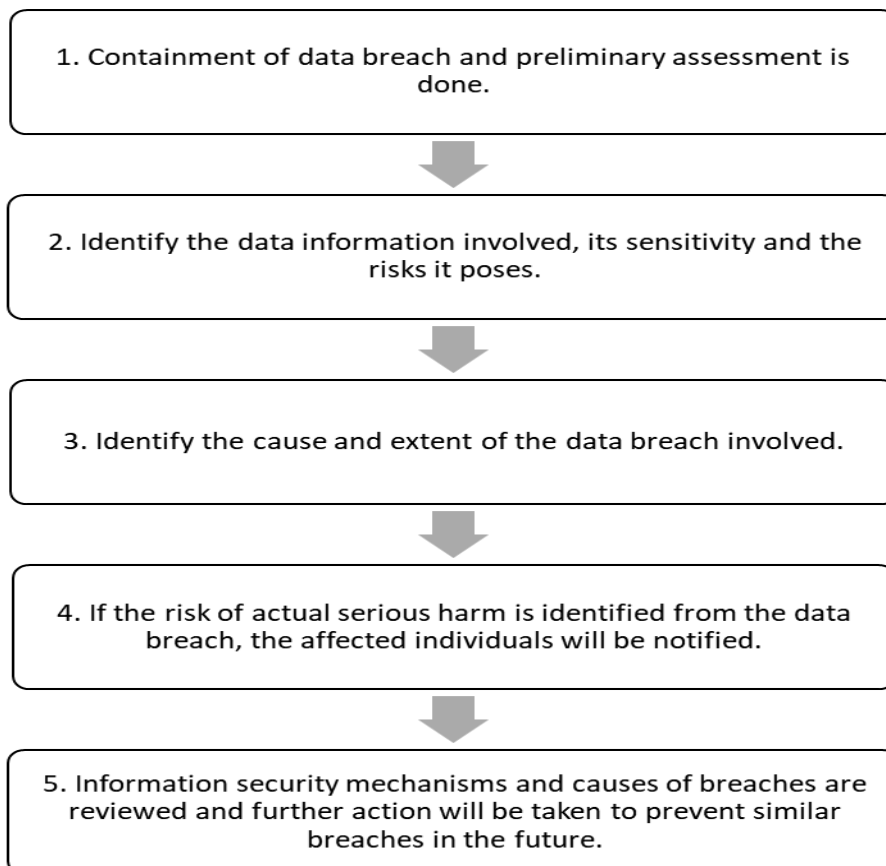

5. How We Use Your Information and Whom We May Disclose It To

The data that we collect is used to help you acquire the goods that the Group provides more easily. The Group will use reasonable efforts to keep confidential all information we receive from you. We do not rent, sell, lend, trade or lease the addresses stored in our database to any third parties.

We may also disclose the personal information, other information or data we collect from you if:

- In circumstances where we believe that disclosure is required under the law, to cooperate with regulators or law enforcement authorities; or to protect our rights, property or safety of the Group, our customers or others. The foregoing includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk protection;
- a background check is required. For such a situation, the Group may contract with third parties to perform a background check on our behalf. We may share your information with such a third party provided that such third party uses the information only to perform services as requested by the Group and agrees to maintain the information as strictly confidential.

6. Storage Of Data

Any personal information we collect about our customers will be stored in the Company's database. The Company will take all reasonable and appropriate steps to ensure that the database is managed securely and in accordance with this Policy, and to protect against unauthorised access or unauthorised modification, disclosure or destruction of data.

7. Third Party Consent

If you have provided the personal data of a third party (e.g., your emergency contact person, your authorised representative, contractor, financiers, lawyers) to us, we rely on you to obtain their prior consent to allow us to process their personal data for commercial transaction purposes.

8. Changes to Our Personal Data Protection Policy
